

Young designer competition

NIPPON Paint (Malaysia) Sdn Bhd is calling for entries for the 2008 Nippon Paint Young Designer Award Competition.

Launched on June 28, the competition is open to students enrolled in schools of interior design or architecture in Malaysia. Entrants must be either in the final year of their diploma programme or the third year of their degree programme.

The Gold medal winners of the competition from the two categories will each receive a special trophy, a RM3,000 cash scholarship and a trip, with full board, to visit the Nippon Paint Colour Studio in Tokyo, Japan.

The Silver medal winners from both categories will each receive a RM2,000 cash scholarship; while the two

who receive an honorary mention will each receive a RM500 cash scholarship.

All completed entries for the competition must reach the organiser at No. 10-2, Jalan Tiara 1A, Bandar Baru Klang, 41150

Klang, Selangor, by Sept 30, 2008.

Winners will be announced at an awards ceremony to be held in Kuala Lumpur in November.
